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## **PROJECTS UNDERWAY AT THE DPW:**

- 1. \$110,000.00 Cemetery Repair (CPA funds) Engineering was approved this past spring, work was awarded and began in October. Project is wrapping up and we will be applying for more CPA money soon to continue the next phase.*
- 2. \$125,000.00 war Memorial Park Repair (CPA funds) Engineering was updated, pre-construction meeting held. Project was to begin in September. Is now on hold until the water levels drop. Probably next June or July.*
- 3. \$12,207.00 Historic Plaque Restoration Project. Project was carried out this past summer and completed*
- 4. World War Monument was moved this September from the front of the Town Hall to the Town Park. A garden area was designed with more work to follow in Spring of 2019. WW1 and WW2 plaques were affixed to the stone.*
- 5. \$60,000.00 911 Memorial Park at the Public Safety Building. Two engineering firms have presented proposals to build park. Park will be built in spring of 2019.*
- 6. 25,000.00 Fish ladder design. (CPA funds) Working with Marine Fisheries we are to applying for a second \$25,000.00 for a total of \$50,000.00 for a natural fish ladder design. Federal funds will then be applied for construction.*
- 7. LED sign for transfer station. Funds were put together as an encumbrance of the budget. Designs for the sign and electrical hookup prices, was attained. Permitting is moving through town departments. Hopefully the sign will be completed soon.*
- 8. \$400,000.00 Complete Streets Project. This past year we attended training, set up a committee, put together a Prioritization Plan, and are adopting a policy. We will be applying for funds this spring for sidewalk construction.*
- 9. Safe Routes to School, a Mass DOT program is now accepting applications for grants for sidewalk engineering and construction. At this time we have applied for a \$710,000.00 grant.*
