War Memorial Park

This Historical War Memorial Park is available for weddings, graduations cookouts and company picnics. A fee of \$150.00 has been established for out-of-town groups who wish to use the park. There will be no charge to residents of the town. These fees will be applied to the West Bridgewater Beautification Fund and will be used to improve, maintain and repair our park.

Permits should be signed and returned to the West Bridgewater Police Department and shall contain the following information:

- 1. Estimate of number of guests.*
- 2. Phone numbers and address of parties in charge of function.*
- 3. A statement that releases the town from any liability.*

Park Rules and Regulations

- 1. Park closed sunset to sunrise*
- 2. No alcoholic beverages.*
- 3. No tents or canopies.*
- 4. No amplified sound systems.*
- 5. Horseback and bicycle riding prohibited.*
- 6. Please respect flowers, lawns, stone walls and fences.*
- 7. Park only in designated areas. No vehicles are allowed on lawn areas.*
- 8. Read and understand posted rules sign at park. Strictly enforced!*
- 9. Remove all trash generated from picnic and or function.*

A \$25.00 fee for use by out of town groups.
All fees will go to maintenance of the grounds.*
